The Georgia Department of Education data shows that 93% of the students who take 3 or more Technical Education courses will graduate from High School.

Maxwell has updated its curriculum offerings to ensure that students will have room in their schedules to attend classes at Maxwell. These changes were made in response to the new graduation requirements, and the addition of the 4th science unit for students graduating 2012 and beyond.

Enrollment Options for the 2010-2011 school year

3 periods of a Maxwell course

2 periods of a Maxwell course and JR Language Arts

2 periods of a Maxwell course and any on-line class needed for graduation

2010-2011 school year

- Graduating seniors, who need a technical concentration area, and wish to earn the credit at Maxwell, must register for 3 periods of a Maxwell course. Any other student, with three open class periods, may register for 3 periods of a Maxwell course.
- We are now offering JR LA as part of Maxwell's 3 class periods.
- Students may take an online course, through Gwinnett's On-Line Campus, as part of Maxwell's 3 class periods, and receive adult supervision and support while at Maxwell.
- Online registration for all Maxwell programs begins in January and continues through the start of school in August 2010.
- Cisco Dual Enrollment with Gwinnett Technical College & Maxwell. Students will ride the bus from their home high school to Maxwell, then board the bus to GTC.

2011-2012 school year

- Offering 4th science unit, in every Maxwell program, for graduating seniors who entered 9th grade for the first time in the 2008-09 school year and subsequent years. The 4th science unit may be used to meet both the science and elective requirements (www.doe.k12.ga.us: Code: IHF(6): 160-4-2-.48).
